NAI Commercial Okanagan Ltd is pleased to present this opportunity to purchase a rustic country home w/ large shop, outbuildings, greenhouse and enclosed gardens on a 58.19 acre parcel located in the tight-knit lakeside community of Celista on the north shore of Lake Shuswap.

The residence is a 3-bed, 2-bath, rancher w/ a large unfinished walkout basement that backs onto a pond teeming with rainbow trout. The shop has 400 amp service w/ 3-Phase Power & consists of a main area of 24' by 60' + an addition of 70' by 15' currently used as a full service custom cabinet & millwork facility. The land is mostly flat and accessible with approx. 4 acres being used to cultivate hay.

The rest are a mix of woodlands and meadows w/ a small portion of wetlands that provide sub irrigation to the hay fields which yield 2 crops per year. Soils vary and include several sections of peat moss soil. Income potential from standing timber. The improved portion of the property is separated by the banks of Celistown Creek that flows through the property. Down the road is North Shuswap Elementary school, The Sunnyside Supermarket and the Celista Hall Farm Market. Only 10 min away from Scotch Creek and less than 1 hour from Salmon Arm. The area is known for considerable agricultural productivity & teems with outdoor adventure activities such as hiking, mountain biking, golfing, cross-country skiing, snowmobiling & water sports.


